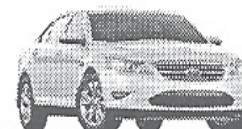

Strollin' With Stroman



By Dean Stroman

Man it is cold outside. Old man winter has finally come down to East Texas. We had one of the mildest Decembers in memory with most of Fork's water temperature well above fifty degrees during which time bass fishing was great. The shallow and deep bite lasted the whole month. Now with cold water temperatures in the mid to high forties most Fork bass will be hanging around timber and grass right on the creek channel's breaklines. The closer grass or timber is to the breakline, the better.

The key to shallow water fishing are these breaklines. Look for areas where channels run seven to

fifteen foot depths with the surrounding water area in the two to six foot depth range. Bass will group up in channels and creeks during cold water conditions. In most of Fork's creeks this water depth will occur around middle creek areas.

Around deeper creeks on Fork, the twenty foot feeding flats, points and roadbeds, look for thirty foot breaklines. Some of the top winter locations on Lake Fork is when you can find deep ledges of creeks that run close to points or flats with the deep side dropping from twenty to thirty plus feet with timber in these breaklines. Bridges and roadbeds are also top locations for Fork's big'uns.

When you find balls of

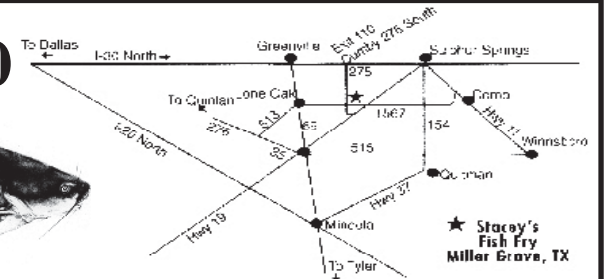

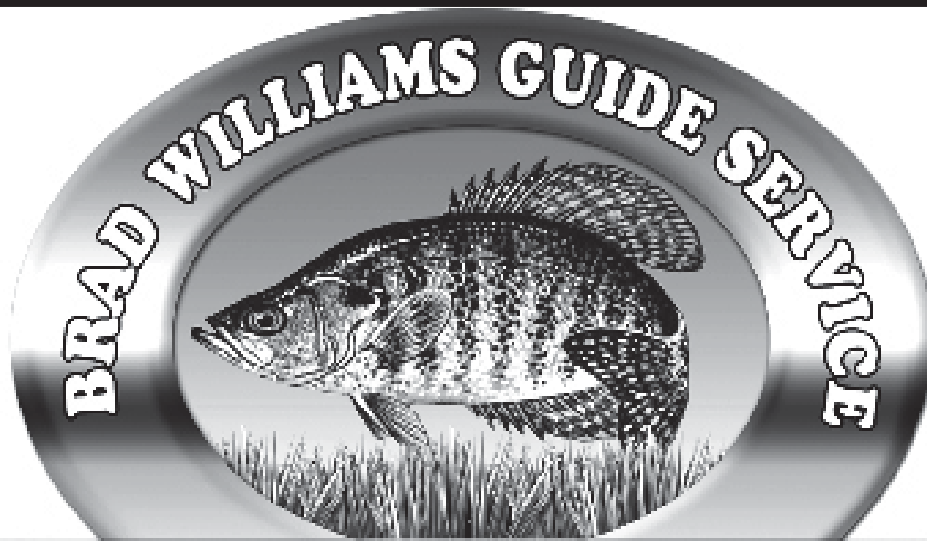

baitfish on or near these breaklines, fish the area thoroughly. Sometime during the day bass will move in to feed. Usually this will be during the warmest part of the day.

During the first couple of weeks in January, deep and shallow bite both can produce, but during the end of the month shallow bite, fifteen feet or less, will start producing the best bite. Hard suspending jerk bits, red lipless cranks, jig/craw are top lure choices for Fork's cold water shallow bass, fifteen feet or less.

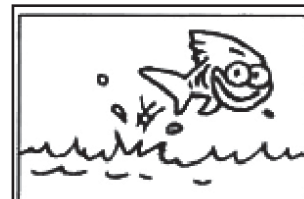
For deep water, jiggging spoons sidewinder spoons, tail kickers, football jigs in black/blue and solid white jig/trailer are hard to beat for Fork's deep bass. If you are after that dream bass and want to put the odds in your favor, pitching black/blue jig with Biffle Bug trailer around breaklines that have heavy timber in and around the breakline will get you that quality bite.

For tournament anglers who target sixteen inch under bass, tomato red trick worms on dropshot rig or wacky style will get you your five fish limit in the same areas.

TPWD Game Warden Field Notes

The following items are compiled from recent Texas Parks and Wildlife Department law enforcement reports.

--An Oily Situation-- A Reeves County game warden received a call from Ward County regarding some illegal hunting taking place near an oil rig. The caller said the three out-of-state hunters were driving the oilfield roads shooting dove from their vehicle. The warden responded to the call that night after the men got off work and saw them cruising the roads, but not shooting. After the vehicle disappeared, the warden waited at the rig to talk to the three men and confirm the hunting story. After some discussion, the three men admitted to shooting dove on the oilfield roads with a pellet gun. The men were charged with hunting without a license and hunting dove by illegal means.

--Learning by Example -- While serving an arrest warrant in Lubbock County, two South Plains game wardens heard a distant shotgun blast and decided to investigate. The wardens found a maize field with several guided hunters and a hunting guide, all hunting. When the wardens contacted the group, the guide tried diverting their attention from a large pile of doves and a certain shotgun. After some questioning by the wardens, the guide admitted to having shot more than his daily bag limit of dove with an unplugged shotgun. Citations were issued.

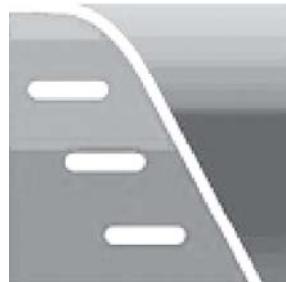
--Covering for a Cousin -- A Williamson County game warden was patrolling a new section of a farm-to-market road that dissects several ranches that is not yet open to the public when he spotted a vehicle inside a ranch with a subject standing nearby drinking

a beer. The warden watched the individual for about 15 minutes before he heard a gunshot in the distance beyond the truck. When the subject spotted the warden, he immediately got out his phone and appeared to be calling someone. The warden started his truck and continued down the road giving the subject the perception that he was leaving. After waiting down the road for a while, the warden returned to the location where the subject was parked and spotted another male with his son near the truck shooting at several doves well after sunset. The warden parked his truck and walked several hundred yards to make contact with the hunters. When he arrived, the hunter with his son was no longer there. The lone hunter was in compliance with state laws and told the warden that the other man was his cousin and was heading back to the house. The man was stalling answering questions about the other hunter as if buying time for his cousin's escape. The warden was able to make it

back to his patrol truck, drive to the front of the property, and find the hunter before he got away. As the warden tried to conduct a compliance check on the man, he denied hunting and became verbally aggressive. The warden advised Williamson County of the situation and requested back up. When two deputies arrived, the man became more compliant, admitted to hunting and said he hid his shotgun in his cousin's truck. It was discovered that the man not only shot at a dove after sunset, but he did not have a hunting license, or identification.

--Can I Keep Him? After receiving a call from the Travis County Sheriff's Office, a game warden responded to a Lakeway residence shortly after midnight where the tenants possessed live white-winged dove in an oversized cage. The birds had been brought to the home three or four months ago as nestlings in order to nourish them for release. When asked why

Louisiana Creole Seafood Gumbo

Warm, savory, hearty... Louisiana seafood gumbo is the ultimate comfort food. And no wonder, its origin is a rich African stew, melded by gombo or okra, and served for in-gatherings.

Creole Seafood Gumbo

1-1/2 cups oil

1-1/2 cups flour

3 cups scallions, chopped

2 cups yellow onion, chopped

5 cloves garlic, chopped

1 tsp. dill weed

4 bay leaves, whole

Cayenne pepper to taste

3 lbs. Louisiana shrimp,

31-35 count, peeled

3 qts. water, hot

1 lb. Louisiana blue crab claw meat

1 lb. Louisiana lump blue crab meat

1 pt. Louisiana oysters, reserving liquid

In large heavy pot over low flame, brown flour in oil, stirring constantly until golden brown. Add vegetables, herbs and seasonings; gently stir until vegetables are soft.

Add shrimp and simmer until pink. Pour in hot water and reserved oyster liquid; blend carefully. Add claw crabmeat and cook over medium heat approximately 45 minutes. Add lump crabmeat and oysters. Cook until oyster edges curl, about 5 minutes. Ladle gumbo over rice in soup bowl. Serves 12.

--Game Fish Aren't Bait --

A Dimmit County game warden was checking some fishermen along a recently flooded river and noticed a man sitting by himself and not wanting to look his way. After the warden contacted the man and checked his fishing license, the warden noticed a bait bucket in the water. The warden asked the man about the kind of bait he was using and he replied, "Some shad that I caught." After an inspection of the bait bucket, the warden found the fisherman in possession of seven under sized crappie and five under-

sized largemouth bass mixed in with the shad and minnows. All of the undersized game fish were released, and citations issued for possession of under-sized game fish.

--Little White Lies --

A Tarrant County game warden was checking fishermen on Lake Grapevine when she pulled up to a boat that was drift-fishing for catfish. When she made contact, she noticed some large fish scales next to an open pocket knife. As the men searched for their fishing licenses, the warden noticed a small white bass on the floor of the boat next to one of the men's feet. She asked the men what they were using for bait, and they

pointed to a bucket of shad. The warden retrieved the white bass from the floor of the boat, and it was missing one fillet and its tail. The men were asked to reel in their lines, and two of the four lines had been baited with the undersized white bass. The men received an education about the illegality of using game fish for bait, and citations were issued.

--A Shot in the Dark -- A McLennan County game warden received a trespass call. While unable to immediately locate the individuals, he decided to wait in the area. After dark, the warden saw a vehicle stop

just down the road and noticed a group of people get out with an AR-15 rifle and flashlight. They began to shoot off the road into a nearby creek and field, so the warden approached the group and issued a citation for discharging a firearm from a public road. No evidence of hunting from the road was found. Forty-five minutes later, another truck stopped down the road in the same general area, and a man got out of the truck with an AK-47 and fired numerous rounds into the creek. When the warden made contact with the shooter, he noticed open containers in the vehicle.

The subject said he was testing his AK-47 on the turtles in the creek. No turtles were located and citations were issued.

6. Fishing hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (official clock at sign-in station). NO FISHING from midnight till start time.
7. Fishing will be done on Lake Fork only (trailer allowed).
8. Contestants must fish from a boat. No bank fishing or leaving the boat to land a fish.
9. Life jackets must be worn any time their outboard motor is running.
10. All state, federal, and local laws must be obeyed or contestant and fish may be disqualified. No slot fish may be brought to weigh-in.
11. No one may have more than five (5) fish in their possession at any time. Only one (1) may be 24" or greater.
12. Largemouth bass 12" to 16" or 24" or greater in length may be weighed. No fish under 12" or between 16" and 24" will be weighed (or state law limits at the time of the tournament).
13. All fish must be caught on artificial bait by casting. (No trolling with gas engine). Pork trailer may be used.
14. Weigh-in starts at 3:00 p.m. (official clock at sign-in). You must be in the weigh-in line by 3:30 p.m.
15. All fish must be brought to the scales in weigh-in bags.
16. No iced or frozen fish will be weighed. Ice may be added ONLY to aid in survival of fish.
17. Each contestant will be responsible for weighing his or her own fish. (No pooling of fish).
18. Dead fish at weigh-in will be penalized 1/2 (.5) pound. All fish weighed in become the property of Texas Trails Bassmasters and will

- be released (with the exception of trophy or dead fish).
19. In the event of a tie for any position, prize money for that position and the following position will be combined and evenly divided between the tying contestants.
20. Contestants may not have served as a compensated guide on Lake Fork 30 days prior to this tournament.
21. Contestants may fished with a guide on Lake Fork prior to the day before fishing this TTB tournament.
22. Use of ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES or CONTROLLED DRUGS are prohibited during tournament hours. Prescription drug use should be declared at sign-in.
23. Anyone who has ever been disqualified for cheating or misconduct from any tournament is ineligible to fish.
24. Any contestant who violates any rule may be disqualified. Any act of a competitor, verbal or physical, that reflects unfavorably upon Texas Trails Bassmasters effort to promote fishing, conservation, clean waters, courtesy or safety shall be reason for disqualification from this and all future Texas Trails Bassmasters tournaments.
25. Parent or guardian must accompany contestants under 18 years of age.
26. All protests must be registered in writing with the tournament judges within 15 minutes after designated weigh-in time. All decisions of the tournament judges will be final in all matters. Anyone protesting the outcome of an Open tournament will have to pay for any additional polygraph test given.
27. All boats must be 8 feet in length or longer. An aerated live well is recommended to aid in fish survival for live release. Anglers cannot leave boat to land a fish.
28. All contestants are responsible to have read these rules and must agree to abide by them (by signing the entry form) while competing in this Texas Trails Bassmasters event.
29. Contestants will be subject to polygraph test. Failure to take and/or pass such a test will result in disqualification.

A total of 20 largemouth bass were entered in November 2012. 20.0% of the fish weighed were over 10 pounds, 40.0% of the fish weighed were above the slot. This month, 8 males and 1 queen reported catches. The data, since March 2012, 12,000 fish have been entered in the survey; 16.0% of all fish weighed were over 10 pounds, and 34.0% of measured fish were over 24 inches.


